## FORMAT:

### QUALIFYING ROUND

Conducted in FOUR DIVISIONS (Women's 10-Pin, Women's 5-Pin, Men's 5-Pin & Men's 10-Pin). 16 Competitors in each division. Each division conducted as follows:

Round Robin Qualifying Round, Match Play, one game against each competitor, total of 15 games. Each competitor receives full credit for pinfall rolled + bonus pins for winning each match (20 bonus pins in tenpin and 30 bonus pins in fivepin).

At the conclusion of the Qualifying Round, the top 4 Men and the top 4 Women, based on total points earned through the qualifying round (including bonus pins) will have qualified for the Stepladder event. Should there be a tie at the conclusion of the qualifying round for the top 4 positions a one game roll off must be held to determine tied positions. Ties in any other positions (5th through 16th) will average out prize money between the tied bowlers.

### STEPLADDER:

In each division, a stepladder final will be held as follows:

**STEP 1** The 4th place qualifier will compete against 3rd place qualifier. The 3rd place qualifier shall choose who will lead off. One game, sudden victory, scratch/total Pinfall. Winner to advance to Step 2.

**STEP 2** Winner of Step 1 will compete against 2nd place qualifier. 2nd place qualifier shall choose who will lead off. One game, sudden victory, scratch/total Pinfall. Winner to advance to Stepladder Final.

### STEP 3 STEPLADDER FINAL

In each division, the winner of Step 2 will compete against the 1st place qualifier in the Stepladder Final. The 1st place qualifier shall choose who will lead off. A maximum of 2 games will be bowled (excepting a tie-breaker). The 1st place qualifier need win only 1 game in the Final to be declared Champion. Should the 1st game be won by the 1st place qualifier the second game will not be bowled. The winner of Step 2 must win both games in the Finals to upset the #1 cede and become the Champion.

In all rounds of the Stepladder, a tie will result in a complete game being bowled to determine who advances.

### PRIZE MONEY

\$100,000 in Prize Money will be awarded courtesy of Bowl Canada, \$25,000 in each division as follows:
