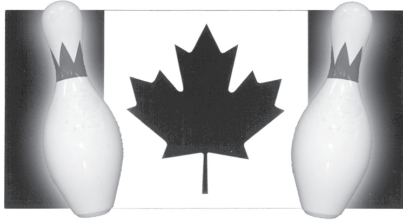

CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT

QUALIFYING ROUND

Conducted in TWO DIVISIONS (Men's & Women's)
9 Competitors in each division.

Each division conducted as follows:

Round Robin, Match Play, two games against each province, total of 16 games

Each competitor receives full credit for pinfall rolled + 20 bonus pins for winning each match.

At the conclusion of the Qualifying Round, the top 3 Men and the top 3 Women will have qualified for the Stepladder event.

STEPLADDER SEMI-FINALS

2 Women...2 Men

3rd place qualifier to compete against 2nd place qualifier.

The 2nd place qualifier will choose who leads off.

One game - Scratch / Total Pinfall

Winner to advance to the Stepladder Finals

STEPLADDER FINALS

2 Women...2 Men

Winner of the Semi-Finals will compete against the first place qualifier.

In game 1, the 1st place qualifier can choose to either lead off or bowl 2nd.

If game 2 is required, the bowler who lead off the first game will bowled 2nd in game 2.

A maximum of 2 games will be bowled (excepting a tie-breaker).

The 1st place qualifier need win only 1 game in the Finals to be declared Canadian Champion.

Should the 1st game be won by the #1 cede the second game will not be bowled.

The winner of the Semi-Finals (#2 or #3 cede) must win two games in the Finals to upset the #1 cede and become the Canadian Champion.

Canadian Champions (1 man and 1 woman) will represent Canada at the
